



DISPENSING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS*

[Read all of this information and instructions carefully before dispensing from the Topi-Click™.](#)

Step 1



Pop off the cap of the Topi-Click® container by placing your thumb under the tab on the protective outer cap and pressing upward.

Step 2



Turn the base to dispense the number of clicks specified on label.



When rotating base, **watch** the Visual Indicators

Indicator Node on Body is fixed at the Click Point



Indicator Column moves with Base. This shows Node in line with column.

LEAVE IN THIS POSITION
AFTER EVERY CLICK
(The Home Position)

Step 3



Apply treatment by rubbing the cream, which is now on the top of the applicator pad, to the area of skin as directed.

Step 4



Prevent evaporation of next dose, by snapping the cap on completely.

Step 5



The **bottom** of the plunger is the indicating line; when it reaches the embossed line **above** the word "Refill," there are approximately 12 clicks left. Approx. 32 clicks remain at the line **below** the word "Refill" as shown above.

The Topi-Click® is a one-time use container and not refillable.



TRANSDERMAL APPLICATION SITES



WASH HANDS BEFORE AND AFTER APPLICATION.

Be sure to rotate application sites to prevent skin irritation and reduce skin tears. Use at least 4 different sites.

Do NOT apply on the head and neck or below the knees or elbows. Avoid the shaded areas on the drawings. The fronts of the thighs are the preferred sites of application (sites 21-24). Also avoid skin folds, scar tissue, burned, cut, or irritated areas. The areas should be clean, moist, and reasonably hairless. Hair is likely to interfere with application. Hair can be clipped, but NOT shaved.
